Your responsibilities include assisting the Radiation Safety Officer in managing the Radiation Safety Program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending and verifying corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations.

You are required to notify management, including the DO, if any NCRFO staff does not cooperate with addressing radiation safety issues. It is estimated that you will spend an average of 5 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.
