Mr. Kaplan,

Thanks for discussing the change of control of Jefferson Paving to W-L Construction today. Based on our discussion, I understand that

- W-L Construction does not intend to amend the NRC Virginia license to add either the gauges from Jefferson Paving, or the West Virginia location
- The RSO at the former Jefferson Paving is continuing to oversee licensed activities in West Virginia; the location is under a 1-year lease so another location will have to be found eventually
- Neither RSO was aware of the change until after it happened.

As I told you, I have a call into Bruce Terris at Jefferson Paving/W-L construction, to discuss what is needed in order for the NRC to approve this change, and to see what needs to be amended on that license.

Since I spoke with you, Juan Ayala also contacted me. He had discussed this as well with you and Bruce Terris. He discussed the information that we need from the West Virginia license about this change of control, but we have not yet received anything.

I appreciate you time today. If any of my understandings are incorrect, please let me know.
