Dear Ms. Edwards:

This is in reference to your Notification dated November 23, 2022, informing the NRC that George Pavlonnis, AMP was appointed as a temporary Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Information related to Notifications for temporary RSOs are subject to inspection.

In the Notification, you provided supporting documentation including Mr. Pavlonnis' qualifications. The NRC has initiated a review of this information and requests additional information specifically regarding compliance with requirements in 10 CFR 35.50, "Training for Radiation Safety Officer," as well as 10 CFR 35.14, "Notifications," and, 10 CFR 35.24, "Authority and responsibilities for the radiation protection program." The following information is specifically requested:

1. Relative to the NRC form 313A (RSO), Table 5c. needs to be completed documenting Mr. Pavlonnis' training for all modalities listed on the license. The form indicates that the Board certificate be provided and if the board certificate is not one recognized by the NRC, then a preceptor needs to be provided for the training documented in Table 5c. Additionally, if the training and board certification are older than seven years, documentation of recentness of training needs to be provided as required by 10 CFR 35.59.
2. Please indicate when Mr. Pavlonnis was appointed as temporary RSO.
3. Please indicate when Mohammed Aljallad, Ph.D., RSO began his leave of absence and when you expect him to return to this position.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at:

Given the time sensitivity of this issue, we request that you submit your response to this letter as soon as possible but no later than 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. Please submit a letter signed by management which may be scanned and attached to an email.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web Site at: <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>. Please be aware that you may request that certain portions of your submittal to NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
