This meeting will help to prepare licensees and other entities for the upcoming reporting of drug and alcohol testing information to the NRC for calendar year 2022. Commercial nuclear industry representatives who complete and submit the annual FFD program performance reports to the NRC under 10 CFR 26.417 or 26.717 are encouraged to participate in this meeting. Representatives are encouraged to prepare for this meeting by reviewing NRC Forms 890 and 891 and to develop questions to ask the NRC technical staff regarding FFD reporting requirements.
