Subject: License Renewal Application

Discussion: Discussed application information provided on December 20, 2022. Specifically, the December 20<sup>th</sup> application only requested 3400 series gauges. The current license authorizes 4640 gauges. The licensee stated that they only possess 3400 series gauges and that they no longer need the 4640 authorization. The licensee agreed to remove the 4640 from the license. The licensee also had requested additional 3400 series gauges than currently authorized. The licensee did not realize that the current license authorization was for both the 3400 series and the 4640, and had increased the number of 3400 series requested. The licensee said that they plan to reduce their actual inventory in the future and agreed to keep the current authorized limit for the 3400 series. No changes to the 3400 series limits.

The current license authorizes calibration of gauges and the removal of the source rod for maintenance and cleaning. The licensee said that they used to calibrate their own gauges but stopped doing that a while ago and have been sending their gauges to the manufacturer for calibrations and maintenance. The licensee agreed that this license condition is no longer needed and can be removed.

Action Required: Process renewal application with current authorization for the 3400 series, remove the 4640 authorization, and remove license condition 17 found in license amendment 31.
