

- The Initial License Renewal Application for the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 1 was submitted on July 3, 2023 (ML23184A081)
- The current Renewed License expiration date for Perry is November 7, 2026
- If an initial license renewal is granted, it will be for an additional 20 years



UNITED STATES NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION Protecting People and the Environment

- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)
 - Informs Federal decision making
 - Public disclosure of environmental impacts and other considerations
- NRC's Environmental Regulations in 10 CFR Part 51
- Staff review is to determine if the environmental impacts of license renewal are so great that license renewal would be unreasonable




- Consider, analyze, and disclose environmental impacts of continued plant operation and alternatives to license renewal
- Identify and asses new and significant information regarding generic conclusions reached in the Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal (LR GEIS)
- Evaluate site-specific issues in a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) to the LR GEIS

NRC *Le and the Environment* **Statement (EIS)**

- Staff evaluates impacts to resources
 Fish and wildlife
 - -Water, air, terrestrial resources
 - -Historical and cultural resources
 - Socioeconomics
 - -Environmental justice
 - -Human health
 - -Land use


