Purpose

- The purpose of this meeting is to discuss a proposed license amendment request (LAR) for the Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS)
- The proposed license amendment would revise the CNS Emergency Plan.

License Amendment Request Overview

- Approval of proposed Cooper Nuclear Station Emergency Plan requested.
- This revision establishes an updated licensing basis using NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Revision 2, and RIS 2016-10
- Proposed revision complies with 10CFR50.47(b) and 10CFR50, Appendix E

License Amendment Request Overview

- Submittal content will include:
 - Enclosure 1: Change Evaluation
 - Enclosure 2: Proposed Cooper Nuclear Station Emergency Plan
 - Enclosure 3: Offsite Response Organization (ORO) concurrence letters
 - Posting of LAR bases and analysis files
- Changes to the proposed Emergency Plan:
 - Staffing changes to align with NUREG-0654
 - New format and content to align with NUREG-0654

License Amendment Request Overview

- Proposed deviations include:
 - Dose Assessment Collateral Duty Assigned to On-Shift Radiological/Chemistry Personnel
 - No Minimum Staff Technical Support Center (TSC) Emergency Director Position
 - No Minimum Staff TSC ORO Communicator Position
 - No Minimum Staff TSC Dose Assessor
 - No dedicated Minimum Staff Onsite Field Monitoring Team (FMT) Technician Position
 - Single Maintenance Supervisor Position
 - No Minimum Staff Onsite FMT Driver

License Amendment Request Overview

- Proposed deviations continued:
 - TSC Emergency Notification System Communicator at 90 minutes
 - Operational Support Center Maintenance at 90 minutes
 - Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) Operations/Emergency Operating Procedures Advisor (Classification Advisor) at 90 minutes
 - EOF Offsite Communicator at 90 minutes
 - EOF Dose Assessor at 90 minutes

- Estimated 1-yr NRC review time from acceptance
