NRC Security Status Update for the ADVANCE Act Section 507



May 21, 2025



Security Response to Section 507 of the ADVANCE Act:

In response to Section 507 of the ADVANCE ACT, the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR) conducted a thorough review and assessment of the physical and cybersecurity oversight and inspection program to identify efficiencies, eliminate redundancies, and standardize routine processes while ensuring a risk-informed, performance-based approach to security oversight and inspection functions.



Status of Security Initiatives for Operating Reactors



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 1 for Operating Rx

- Revise the inspection frequency for IP 71130.07 "Security Training" from biennial to triennial.
- Status: Complete IP 71130.07 has been revised
- Implementation: Start of 10th ROP triennial cycle CY 2026
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Travel resources, inspection planning/preparation, use of technology/data, preparation/documentation time (Section 507 (d)(1)(A), (B), and (C))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 2 for Operating Rx

- Perform a risk-informed evaluation of all inspection requirements in security baseline IPs to validate prioritization (i.e., Tier I, II, and III)
- Minimum samples will constitute procedure completion.
- Status: In progress IP revisions are underway.
- Implementation: January 2026
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Risk-inform procedures, balance level of resources with safety significance, review inspection resources based on licensee performance (Section 507 (d)(3)(A) and (B))



- Apply risk-informed and performance-based principles.
 - Prioritize and scope each inspection to be commensurate with risk and licensee performance, considering previous inspection findings, performance indicators, and corrective action program reviews.
- Aligns with NSIR initiative 1 and 2
 - Inspection frequency and risk informed evaluation
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for implementation
- Status: In progress
- Implementation: January 2026



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 3 for Operating Rx

- Develop an inspection schedule for security baseline inspections to reduce travel costs and maximize time on-site.
 - For instance, IPs 71130.02, .05, and .14 would be inspected during the same week, possibly reducing two additional trips to the site.
- Status: In progress
- Implementation: CY 2027
 - Inspection schedules and licensee drill dates are already developed for CY 2026.
 This timeline will allow the regions to coordinate with licensees.
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Travel resources, inspection preparation/documentation time, documentation collection time (Section 507 (d)(1)(A),(B)and (C))

IP 71130.05- Protective Strategy Evaluation and Performance Evaluation Program

IP 71130.14- Review of Power Reactor Target Sets



- Optimize the use of fleet-level inspections.
- Aligns with NSIR Initiative 3
 - Inspection schedule
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for implementation
- Status: Not started
 - For inspections that involve the corporate office, the region will coordinate inspections with the site and corporate office to maximize resources and reduce duplicate effort.
- Implementation: CY 2027



- Re-allocate inspection resources to gain efficiencies in travel resources.
 - Assess current inspection scope for the resident inspectors, region, and headquarters and divide the scope to gain efficiency (e.g., target sets, lock and key, evaluated Force on Force).
- Aligns in part with NSIR Initiative 3
 - Inspection schedule
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted in part for implementation
- Status: In progress
 - This initiative will be implemented in part by creating efficiencies though the scheduling and resources of inspections.
 - Example: Resident inspectors who are target set qualified, may conduct that inspection thus reducing travel resources.
 - Inspectors must hold qualifications for the program area they inspect.
- Implementation: CY 2026



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 4 for Operating Rx

- Develop a standard request for information template for each IP.
- Status: Complete Templates have been developed for each IP
- Implementation: Effective July 1, 2025, and January 1, 2026
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Inspection Preparation/documentation time, documentation collection time (Section 507 (d)(1)(B)and (C))

- Standardize requests for information to support baseline inspection activities.
- Aligns with NSIR Initiative 4
 - Request for information template
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for implementation
- Status: In progress
- Implementation: July 1, 2025, and January 1, 2026



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 5 for Operating Rx

- Expand the language in Inspection Manual Chapter (IMC) 0612 and 0612 App B for Very Low Safety Significance Issue Resolution (VLSSIR) to add clarity for security related inspection issues of concern.
- Status: Completed- Revisions have been made to associated IMCs
- Implementation: May 2025
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Level of resources commensurate with the safety significance (Section 507 (d)(3)(A))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 6* for Operating Rx

SRM-COMSECY 19-0006 (FOF Revisions)

- Reduces inspection procedure (IP) 71130.03 Force-on-Force (FOF) inspection program from 2
 NRC conducted exercises to 1 exercise.
- Reduction of hours in IP 71130.03 from 393 hours to 275 hours.
- SRM was underway prior to the ADVANCE Act; implementation will incorporate the ADVANCE Act goals.
 - Incorporated additional enhancements to eliminate inspection redundancies, enhance guidance for inspection planning and performance, reduce impact of licensee and NRC resources.

NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 6* for Operating Rx (cont.)

- Status: In progress- revisions to the inspection procedures are close to completion.
- Implementation: January 1, 2026, Start of Triennial FOF Cycle 9
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Travel resources, inspection planning/preparation, preparation/documentation time, elimination of duplicative activities (Section 507 (d)(1)(A), (B), and (C) and (d)(2)(A))



- Review inspection procedures and eliminate duplicative inspection requirements.
 - 71130.03 and 71130.05
- Aligns with NSIR Initiative 6
 - SRM-COMSECY-19-0006
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for implementation
- Status: In progress- revisions to the inspection procedures are close to completion.
- Implementation: January 2026



• Credit for licensee performance during force-on-force inspections.

- Implement an inspection model like the emergency preparedness (EP) evaluated exercises as an approach to demonstrate reasonable assurance in FOF inspections if a licensee's baseline performance warrants (e.g., no action matrix movement due to security performance).
- In part, aligns with NSIR initiative 6
 - SRM-COMSECY-19-0006
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted in part for implementation.
 - All FOF related exercise performance deficiencies will screen as green, thus no action matrix movement.
 - Implementation of EP model is not within the existing Commission direction outlined in SRM-COMSECY-19-0006.
 - NEI provided a letter to NSIR proposing an EP-like approach for scenario development. As a next step, NSIR will conduct a public meeting to discuss the specifics of the proposal.
- Status: Complete
- Implementation: January 1, 2026



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 7* for Operating Rx

- Revise the Baseline Security Significance Determination Process (BSSDP).
- Status: In progress- draft BSSDP is being developed.
 - Commission approval required. On track to submit a SECY paper in October 2025. A public meeting will be conducted in late spring 2025 to provide an update.
- Implementation: TBD pending Commission approval
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Risk-informed, performance-based assessment, preparation/documentation time, inspection approach with the level of resources commensurate with safety significance (Section 507 (d)(1)(B), (C), and (3)(A))



- Simplify the BSSDP for power reactors.
- Aligns with NSIR initiative 7
 - BSSDP
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for implementation
- Status: In progress, on track for the SECY to go to the Commission in October 2025.
- Implementation: TBD



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 8 for Operating Rx

- Enhance the Security Issues Forum (SIF) process.
- Status: In progress, draft SIF Charter has been developed, will be issued in July 2025.
- Implementation: July 2025
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Improve oversight and inspections (Section 507 (d)(2))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 9 for Operating Rx

- Removed IP 71130.06 "Protection of Safeguards Information" from the baseline inspection program and placed it in IMC 2201, Appendix C, Generic, Special, and Infrequent Inspections.
- Status: Complete
- Implementation: September 1, 2024, and redesignated as IP 81822
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Improve oversight and inspections (Section 507 (d)(2)(A))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 10 for Operating Rx

Cybersecurity Inspection

- Evaluate the inspection frequency and resources.
- Revise the inspection procedure (IP) and request for information (RFI) document.
- Use of risk informed principles for sampling as much as possible.
- Streamline/reduce amount of information requested for inspections.



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 10 for Operating Rx (cont.)

Status:

 Final stages of the evaluation to determine the inspection frequency and resources.

Implementation: January 2026

 Link to ADVANCE Act: Improve oversight and inspections (Section 507 (d)(2)(A))



- Revise the cybersecurity inspection procedure to reflect the maturity of licensee programs.
- Aligns with NSIR Initiative 10
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted for revision
- Status:
 - IP 71130.10 currently under revision (risk-informed sampling, inspection requirements guidance).
 - RFI: Evaluation of proposed ideas to achieve effectiveness and use of modern tools to reduce amount of information requested.
- Implementation: January 2026



- Credit existing performance indicators (PI) for inspection efficiencies.
 - Remove inspection elements that are already being assessed with PIs.
- Aligns with an NRR initiative for Section 507 of the ADVANCE Act
- NRC Evaluation: Accepted
- Status: In progress, working group has been established.
 - Public meeting scheduled for June 5, 2025.
- Implementation: TBD



- Eliminate blind performance test sample submittals to HHS laboratories.
- Revisions to the blind testing program included in "SECY-24-0058, Rulemaking Plan on Drug and Alcohol Testing: Technical Issues and Editor Changes."
- Status: In progress, plan submitted to the Commission in July 2024
- Implementation: TBD



- Augment current urine testing with oral fluid testing for all testing conditions.
- Aligns with "SECY-24-0058, Rulemaking Plan on Drug and Alcohol Testing: Technical Issues and Editor Changes."
- Status: In progress, plan submitted to the Commission in July 2024
- Implementation: TBD



- Redefine the minor/more-than-minor threshold.
- Aligns with the NRR initiative for Section 507 of the ADVANCE Act.
- Evaluation: Accepted
- Status: In progress
- Implementation: 1st Quarter 2026



- Optimize qualifications for armed response force member that continue to meet the reasonable assurance standard.
 - Consider NEI Annual FOF Exercise Whitepaper
- NRC Evaluation: Complete
 - NEI provided for the whitepaper to the NRC for information only, not approval.
- Status: Concerns with regulatory compliance were communicated during a public meeting on 3/27/25. Currently, with NEI to decide path forward.
- Implementation: TBD



Status of Security Initiatives for Fuel Cycle Facilities



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 1 for Fuel Cycle Facilities

- Evaluate all CAT I physical security IPs to identify and remove any redundancies.
- Evaluate the combination and elimination of three protective strategy-specific IPs.
 - Keep IPs 81700.05 and 81700.11.
 - Eliminate IP 81700.06.
 - Disperse elements of IP 81700.06 into 81700.05 and 81700.11.
- Status: In progress- revisions are underway to associated IPs
- Implementation: CY 2027
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Reduction in inspection effort (20+ hours), preparation/documentation and reduce travel costs. (Section 507 (d)(1)(A), (B), (C) and (d)(2)(A))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 2 for Fuel Cycle Facilities

- Redesignate IP 81700.10 "Safeguards Information" (SGI) to an "as needed" IP.
- Status: In progress- revisions are underway to the associated IPs
- Implementation: CY 2026
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Improve oversight and inspections, eliminate duplicative activities (Section 507 (d)(2)(A))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 3 for Fuel Cycle Facilities

- Revise template language in the reactor program system (RPS) for CAT I fuel facilities to align with power reactor template language for physical security reports.
- Status: In progress- revision underway
- Implementation: June 2025
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Increase use of templates in documentation (Section 507 (d)(2)(B))



NSIR Oversight and Inspection Initiative 4 for Fuel Cycle Facilities

- Revise IMC 0616, "Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards Inspection Reports" to include language that would allow physical security inspection reports to contain different information than non-security reports.
- Status: Complete- revisions have been made to IMC 0616
- Implementation: June 2025
- Link to ADVANCE Act: Increase use of templates in documentation (Section 507 (d)(2)(B))
