Purpose: The purpose of the meeting is to discuss with Virginia Electric Power Company (the

licensee) a proposed license amendment which proposes to change Technical

Specification (TS) 3.16 Action B.1.a.3 and extend its Allowed Outage Time from 7 days to 14 days to facilitate the replacement of Emergency Diesel Generator 1 cabling. The cable replacement will require a change to Unit 1 and Unit 2 TS to allow Unit 2 to continue to operate while Unit 1 is in outage, and EDG 1 is out of service for cable replacement. A probabilistic risk-informed approach will be used to support this proposed license

amendment.
