Title: Presubmittal Meeting for a Surry Unit 1 and 2 License Amendment Request Proposed change to the Technical Specifications

Date(s) and Time(s): January 14, 2026, 01:00 PM to 02:30 PM ET

Location: Webinar

Category: This is an Observation Meeting. This is a meeting in which attendees will have an opportunity to observe the NRC performing its regulatory function or discussing regulatory issues. Attendees will have an opportunity to ask questions of the NRC staff or make comments about the issues discussed following the business portion of the meeting; however, the NRC is not actively soliciting comments towards regulatory decisions at this meeting.

Purpose: The purpose of the meeting is to discuss with Virginia Electric Power Company (the licensee) a proposed license amendment which proposes to change Technical Specification (TS) 3.16 Action B.1.a.3 and extend its Allowed Outage Time from 7 days to 14 days to facilitate the replacement of Emergency Diesel Generator 1 cabling. The cable replacement will require a change to Unit 1 and Unit 2 TS to allow Unit 2 to continue to operate while Unit 1 is in outage, and EDG 1 is out of service for cable replacement. A probabilistic risk-informed approach will be used to support this proposed license amendment.
