Upon consideration of the November 19, 1999 joint motion of applicant Private Fuel Storage, L.L.C., (PFS) and intervenor State of Utah (Utah) for an extension of time for PFS to file a protective order regarding production of disputed material relating to contention Utah H, Inadequate Thermal Design, which the NRC staff does not oppose, and the appropriate showing having been made to support filing the extension motion less than three business days before the motion due date and for the requested extension, it is

contention Utah H-related information on Tuesday, November 30, 1999; and (2) the State will review that material by Tuesday, December 7, 1999, to determine whether it wishes to maintain its request for the "FLUENT" software package, which is represented to be the remaining matter still in dispute, any PFS protective order relating to production of the "FLUENT" code shall be filed on or before Monday, December 13, 1999, and any State response thereto shall be filed on or before Thursday, December 23, 1999.
