1. Two (2) U.S. Uranium mines sold to Russia. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has approved the license transfer of two Wyoming mines to a Russian company, despite concerns over national security raised by local and national government officials including senior House Republicans.

From the Telegram:

Two uranium mines in Wyoming are on their way to control by a Russian company now that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has approved transferring the mines' licenses. The NRC last week approved the license transfer to a Russian company known as ARMZ which expects to obtain a controlling interest in Canadian-owned Uranium One by year's end. Uranium One holds the licenses for a proposed uranium mine and an existing uranium mine in northeast Wyoming.

The approval comes despite concerns from local and national lawmakers. Both groups worry that Wyoming's uranium could in theory go overseas and serve against U.S. interests.

2. Obama. Argument that the status and meaning of "natural born citizen" under Article II of the U.S. Constitution is a natural right secured by the Constitution and passed on through the citizenship of the father, and that being "natural born" is not changeable by statute [positive law] or case law.
